Pilgrimage to Peru Highlights

November 2-11, 2027

DAY 1 - November 2: Depart the USA from your local airport to Lima, Peru to arrive in the evening.

Overnight in Lima at the Hilton Lima Miraflores.

DAY 2 - November 3: LIMA CITY TOUR & SANTO DOMINGO CONVENT

Mass in the inner chapel of Santo Domingo Convent. We will then tour the Historic Center of Lima, where we will admire the colonial mansions with Moorish-style balconies and other historic buildings such as the Plaza Mayor, the Government Palace, the Cathedral of Lima, Municipal Palace & Santo Domingo Convento. We will also visit the Shrine of Santa Rosa and Shrine of San Martin de Porres, two of Peru's beloved saints.

Overnight in Lima, (B,L)

DAY 3 - November 4: LIMA – CUSCO

Mass at Parroquia La Virgen Milagrosa (Parish of the Virgin of the Miraculous Medal) in Miraflores. At the scheduled time you will be transferred from your hotel to Lima airport for your flight to Cusco. Upon arrival in Cusco, you will be met at the airport and transferred to your respective hotel.

Overnight in Cusco. (B)

DAY 4 - November 5: CUSCO - CITY TOUR & NEARBY RUINS

Mass at the Iglesia Santo Domingo in Cusco. We will explore the Imperial City of Cusco beginning with the Plaza de Armas and the Cathedral which houses beautiful works of art from the Cusco School of Painting. We will continue to the Qorikancha or "Temple of the Sun" which once had walls & floors covered in pure gold. We will then visit Sacsayhuamán one of the most impressive examples of Inca architecture, followed by the amphitheater of Kenko, the water fountains in Tambomachay, and a panoramic view of the red fortress of Puka Pukara. Overnight in Cusco. (B,L)

Day 5 - November 6: CUSCO – FULL DAY PISAC & OLLANTAYTAMBO – SACRED VALLEY

Mass at Iglesia San Francisco. We will start our journey to the "Sacred Valley of the Incas" with a visit to the town of Pisac, where we will have the opportunity to experience the local market and purchase traditional handicrafts and products. Lunch is included in a local restaurant. Then we will continue along the banks of the Urubamba River enjoying beautiful landscapes towards the Military Fortress of Ollantaytambo. We will visit the Temple of the Sun (known for its six massive granite stones) as well as the fascinating archaeological terraces and enclosures of Ollantaytambo.

Overnight in Sacred Valley. (B,L)

Day 6 - November 7: FULL DAY MARAS SALT MINES & MORAY

Mass at Iglesia Señor de Torrechayoc – Urubamba. We will visit the archaeological site of Moray. Situated at an altitude of 3,385 meters (11,106 feet) above sea level. Moray is famous for its remarkable circular agricultural terraces, which create different microclimates at varying elevations. We will continue our excursion to the Salt Mines of Maras, an ancient salt-producing site where salt is still harvested naturally from saltwater springs using a system of terraces and pools.

Overnight in the Sacred Valley. (B,L)

Day 7 - November 8: VALLEY – VISTADOME TRAIN – AGUAS CALIENTES

Mass at Iglesia Señor de Torrechayoc – Urubamba.

At the scheduled time we will transfer to the Ollantaytambo train station to board the Vistadome Train to Aguas Calientes.

Upon arrival at the station, you will be assisted by hotel staff and directed to your hotel.

Overnight in Aguas Calientes (B,D)

Day 8 - November 9: AGUAS CALIENTES – VISIT TO MACHU PICCHU CITADEL – CUSCO

Mass at Iglesia in Aguas Calientes. We will then board the tourist bus that will take us to the Citadel of Machu Picchu, one of the seven Wonders of the World. We will meet our private local guide to visit the principal areas of the citadel, including the urban and agricultural sectors. At the end of the tour, we will have time to descend to the town of Aguas Calientes, for shopping and personal time.

At the indicated time, we will board the return train to Cusco.

Overnight in Cusco. (B,L)

Day 9 - November 10: CUSCO – LIMA

At the scheduled time, we will transfer to Cusco airport to board your flight back to Lima.

Enjoy a farewell dinner in Lima, then to the airport for your overnight flight (B,D)

Day 10 - November 11: Arrival in the USA



DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$1000.00 per person is required to make a reservation, **the final payment is due on August 1, 2027.** We suggest a full payment be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will be accepted but will incur a 4% surcharge. **Reservations received after August 1, 2027** may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS:

There will be no refund for cancellations for any reason after September 1, 2027. **All Deposits are 50% refundable until April 1 and 25% refundable until Aug 1. All deposits are non-refundable after August 1, 2027,** no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed in writing to Duc In Altum. **Trip cancellation insurance is HIGHLY recommended.** All cancellations that occur within 60 days must be submitted through Travel Insurance. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice unless another roommate can be secured.

FARE INCLUSIVE. Roundtrip air transportation from Wichita (ICT) as indicated on the registration form. Nine (9) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room. All meals as outlined in the brochure consist of full Local breakfasts (B), lunches (L) and dinners at the hotel (D). Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches or vans, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local English-speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable. All transfers between airports and hotels by private motor coach. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. All U.S. & Peru departure taxes are included in the price of the tour. The brochure price is per person in US dollars.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: Duc in Altum constantly strives to adhere to the specifics shown in the itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes. Such circumstances may require changes without advance notice during the tour. Duc in Altum Travel reserves the right to change the itinerary if unforeseen circumstances beyond our control force a change. Duc in Altum Travel is not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances.

TOUR CANCELLATION: Duc in Altum reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by Duc in Altum, the sole and exclusive responsibility of Duc in Altum is to refund all monies recovered.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport costs, visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required); food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with the table d'hôte meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, and cable expenses, room service orders, etc.; transportation between the home city and the international departure city. Tips to guides, motor coach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e. maître d', table waiter, etc.)

AIR ROUTINGS: The brochure price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45-day Apex fare. Duc in Altum reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit of \$700.00 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify Duc in Altum in writing on or before August 1, 2027. **Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be processed by Duc in Altum and must be dealt with directly with the airline.** Passengers are responsible for providing frequent-flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are per person, based on two people sharing a room in Deluxe hotels. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$900.00 (tour participants without a roommate will have to pay a single room surcharge).

BAGGAGE: You may check no more than one (1) piece of luggage whose overall dimensions does not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. Checking a second bag will incur an additional baggage fee upon checking in with the airline. Each passenger may also bring one (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Suggested tips to hotel porters include only one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. These regulations may change without notice so please read the monthly correspondence you will receive from Duc in Altum for the most current information. Garment bags cannot be carried. Under no circumstances may dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances be contained in any baggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the difficult terrain at sites we visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. Duc in Altum reserves the right to refuse passage to someone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond that which the tour guide and tour host can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and the sites are not accessible by wheelchair. **A passenger must be able to walk at least two miles over the course of a day, up and down slopes, steps and on uneven terrain.**

All exceptions to this must be submitted in writing and must be accompanied by a qualified physically able travel companion.

INSURANCE: Acting only as agents for suppliers, Duc in Altum is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness and/or death as a result of any occurrences or conditions beyond its control, including, but not limited to, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, or theft. For your protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. Additional information and application forms for all types of coverage will be supplied to you prior to departure.

PASSPORT: **A valid passport, that does not expire before May 12, 2027,** is required and must be obtained in person by each tour member. Complete instructions and application forms for passports can be obtained by contacting your local courthouse or post office.

PRICE CHANGES: Tour conditions and air fares are subject to Governmental, IATA, ARC, and airline regulation requirements in effect at the date of and during the tour. All rates are quoted in US dollars and are based on tariffs and costs in effect in August 2027 and are subject to change without notice. Taxes and fuel surcharges are included in your tour cost and are subject to change without notice. Duc in Altum reserves the right to pass along additional fuel surcharges or additional taxes imposed by the airline.
